WHY? -- TO GAIN A SET OF TABES FOR THE INDEX - A VERY USEFUL TOOL

Why Tab your code book?

- 1 A properly TABBED CODE BOOK makes the Code Book easier to use!
- 2 KNOWLEDGE OF THE NEC CODE - OFTEN MEANS JOB SECURITY & better PAY \$\$\$
- 3 Finding QUICK answers to INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICES BECOMES EASIER
- 4 YOU GET PAID for what YOU KNOW - MORE CODE KNOWLEDGE = MORE PAY -- \$\$\$\$\$\$
- 5 WHEN TAKING YOUR JOURNEYMANS TEST - YOU ONLY HAVE 3 MINUTES PER QUESTION

IT IS QUITE LIKLEY YOU WILL NOT PASS YOUR EXAM WITHOUT A PROPERLY TABBED NEC CODE BOOK

TABBING YOUR CODE BOOK IS EASY WHEN YOU FOLLOW THESE SIMPLY INSTRUCTIONS

Hundreds of 2011 Code Books have been Tabbed using this OUTLINE:

- 1 Mikes Tab sets are marked 1 & 2 - Begin with set 2 placing index tab V-Z 3/16" up from the bottom of the page set the black line of the tabs to the edge of each assending page, touching each line together
The first tab begins on page 821. The 3/16" spacing will protect it from prematurely tearing
- 2 NOTE the 16 tab layout per row fits nicely as described in this document

Start tabbing your NEC Code book - back to front - set first tab V-Z at bottom of page @821, 3/16" off bottom of page

- 1 You will probably use the INDEX Pages more than any other pages in your code book
The INDEX is your guide to finding topical words in the NEC CODE BOOK
* Index KEY WORDS give you section number as a reference - They are found at the top of each page
- 2 Don't forget - the TABLE OF CONTENTS starts on page #2 - It too is VERY USEFUL
The Table of CONTENTS references give you *page numbers*, they are found at the bottom of each page
- 3 Why should I buy the Soft bound code book - When Tabbed as outlined above, the soft copy when folded in half will neatly expose all the tabs for easy reading and quick referencing.
- 4 NOTE: By starting to tab your Code Book from back to front - makes aligning each tab a SNAP!
