250.30 Separately Derived Systems

In addition to complying with 250.30(Å) for grounded systems, or as provided in 250.30(B) for ungrounded systems, separately derived systems must comply with 250.20, 250.21, 250.22, or 250.26, as applicable.

Note 1: An alternate alternating-current power source, such as an on-site generator, is not a separately derived system if the neutral conductor is solidly interconnected to a service-supplied system neutral conductor. An example of such a situation is where alternate source transfer equipment does not include a switching action in the neutral conductor and allows it to remain solidly connected to the service-supplied neutral conductor when the alternate source is operational and supplying the load served.
